We are especially interested in your assessment of the curatorial aspects and methodologies of the exhibition—for example, how it structures and enhances the viewer's experience and understanding of the works it presents or, alternatively, how it fails to do so.
3. A brief (500 words) proposal for a curated project that you would like to realize. Include a preliminary checklist and a brief curatorial abstract.
4. A curriculum vitae
